### **Registration Desk:**

### **Volunteers:**

Each team must provide a certified timekeeper and scorekeeper for each game. While a volunteer for the penalty box is appreciated, it is not mandatory. The CRRRC is equipped with a sound system, allowing you to play music during the games. You can bring your own dongle to connect your phone to the auxiliary input, or you can borrow the necessary attachments from the front desk. Please note that deposits are requested to ensure the return of these attachments.

### **Photo Area:**

A photo area will be created for teams to have a backdrop to take group photos for fun keepsakes.

## Change Rooms and Bag Storage:

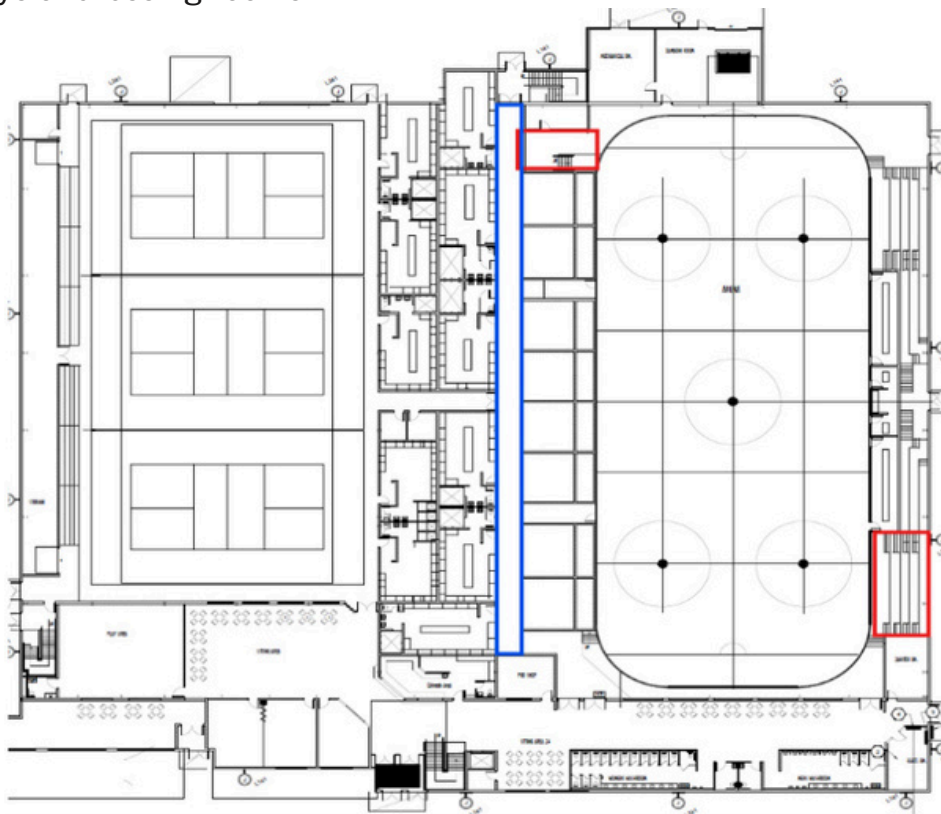
Change rooms will be available 1 hour before the scheduled game. We do not have a designated space for bags to be stored in between games.

## On Ice Warm-up:

Teams will have the standard 3 minutes of on-ice warm-up before each game.

## Dryland Info:

The CRRC is a busy facility. Warmups at the CRRC are only allowed in the highlighted areas in the facility floorplan below; as well as running the stairs on the bleachers if space allows. No running on the walkways for the bleachers and no volleyballs allowed in the dressing room hallway. As the Centennial has very limited space, warmups are only allowed in the dressing room hallway and the dressing rooms themselves. There is no use of hockey or ringette sticks/pucks/rings/practice balls in the hallways or dressing rooms.







## **Niverville CRRC / Centennial Arena Rules and Rental/Facility information:**

- 1 - Absolutely no mini sticks / hockey of any kind in the dressing rooms or hallways.
- 2 - Music in the dressing rooms is okay but please keep the volume at an acceptable level as there are other users throughout the facility.
- 3 - MPR rooms are available to rent in the CRRC and Curling Rink if a team would like somewhere to have meals or hang out between games:
  - MPR 1 & 2: \$51 / hr each
  - Community Room & Kitchen Combo: \$41 / hr
  - Curling Basement & Lobby: \$25 / hr eachPlease call (204) 388-4600 to check availability and reserve a spot.
- 4 - Children must be supervised by an adult at ALL times.
- 5 - Indoor playground is open from 9am – 9pm daily and can be accessed with the purchase of a day pass and must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- 6 - If there is an Open Gym event happening in the field house, a day pass is required and must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- 7 - Access to the walking track is available with the purchase of a day pass and must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- 8 - **Centennial Specific (note, NOT CRRC)** – everyone must stay in the lobby until after the zamboni is off the ice and the gates are closed (this is for safety reasons).

### **Day Pass Fees:**

#### **\*Niverville Resident:**

\$2/person or \$5 / family per day.

#### **Non-Resident:**

\$4/person or \$10 / family per day.

*\*Resident is someone that pays property or business taxes in Niverville.*

## Bar/Alcohol Sales

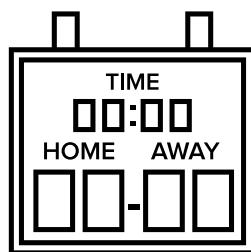
The CRRC is a licensed facility offering alcohol sales to those 18+.

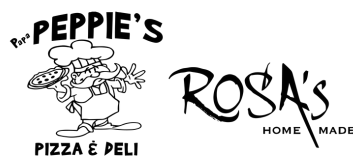
